

Fairburn Baptist Association (FBA) Pastors Trail Walking Club: Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk

Introduction and Acknowledgments

This Release of Liability applies to the event series known as "FBA Pastors Trail Walking Club" or "Walk and Not Faint," operating on Mondays between March 30 and May 11, 2026, at various nature park locations in South Fulton, Fayette, and Coweta Counties.

By participating, you (the "Participant") acknowledge that this activity involves physical movement and walking on nature trails, which may include uneven surfaces, pavement, or wooded terrain.

1. Risk Assumption and Disclaimer

Participant voluntarily understands and accepts all inherent risks, known and unknown, associated with trail walking in nature parks, including but not limited to: falls; slippery terrain; exposure to nature, wildlife, insect bites, or changing weather; overexertion; or interaction with other park users.

The Participant acknowledges that FBA and the associated trail locations (including The Ridge Nature Area, Peachtree City facilities, Line Creek Trails, Kenwood Park, Cannongate Nature Area and Flat Creek Nature Area) provide trail descriptions but are not responsible for trail safety. Participants are expected to bring water and wear appropriate footwear.

2. Physical Condition and Health

By completing the Sign-Up Form, Participant certifies that they are in adequate physical condition to engage in a low-pressure, conversational-paced walking activity lasting 30-45 minutes. Participants understand they are permitted and encouraged to peel off the walk at any point if needed.

3. Waiver and Release of Liability

In consideration for being allowed to participate in this walking club, Participant hereby irrevocably and unconditionally releases, holds harmless, and promises not to sue the Fairburn Baptist Association, Jimmy Kinnaird (AMS), the various Trail Hosts, and the municipal entities governing the walking locations, from any and all liability, claims, or damages, including negligence, for injury, death, or property damage resulting directly or indirectly from their participation.

4. Image Release and Weather Policy Acknowledgments

- Participant grants FBA the right to use any photograph or dynamic image of the walking group taken during the Monday events for promotional use on fairburnba.org, newsletters, or social media (unless Participant explicitly opts out via written notice prior to the walk).

- Participant acknowledges and accepts the FBA Trail Walking Club rain/cancellation policy as stated: [OPTION A/B: e.g., Light rain we walk. Thunder/lightning cancellations will be texted by 7:30 AM.
